Recent work has included a lot more of the kinds of mixed media that work with watercolour paints. She also frequently works with print media, inks, gouache, pastels and pencils. She is intensely interested in Geology, plant forms, Astronomy, Folklore, Myth and, always, the sea.

Elaine trained as an Illustrator and Graphic Designer at Southampton Faculty of Art & Design. She then went on to do a year of Fine Art at L'Ecole des Beaux Arts in Le Havre.

This three week workshop is suitable for artists of all abilities so no experience necessary.
