# Fareham Art Group 75th Anniversary Art and Craft Exhibition by Carole Jarman

Fareham Art Group once again held their annual Art Exhibition and Craft Fair at Titchfield Community Centre on Saturday 26th October and Sunday 27th October.

On Friday the Committee and volunteers spent the afternoon erecting tables and screens and hanging works of art. There was a lot of hustle and bustle as the crafters laid out their wares on the 14 tables in the three rooms and the café area was organised for the influx of the public over the weekend. The Tombola and art sales tables were sorted, ready for Friday night, and the visiting public on Saturday morning.

The Exhibition was opened by the Mayor of Fareham at the members preview evening. Judging took place by the Mayor and guest artist Pip McGarry and prizes were awarded to the members for their chosen arts and crafts. Over two hundred and fifty paintings were on show, demonstrating the varied talents of our members and different art styles. This year a record number of visitors exceeding 1000 attended the Exhibition in celebration of the clubs 75 th Anniversary.

In addition to the paintings, we invited crafters to come along to sell their articles and make the show more varied. We had 14 stalls selling jewellery, Christmas items and unique pictures made using sea glass and shells. A stall with beautiful cushions and aprons and another selling lanterns. All were so varied and of course unique cards designed by the artisans.

Craft items and paintings were purchased as Christmas presents and children came along to join in the fun, especially the Tombola and guess the name of the Teddy Bear.

The art stall selling all kinds of art and craft materials and art books was a great favourite, but the busiest area of all was the café. No-one could resist the home made sausage rolls and the abundance and variety of homemade cakes and savories, all made and donated by our members.

This year our group project was Fareham Past and Present. Fifty members painted the scene of their choice on canvas and the collection was displayed at the show. Some depicted old Fareham scenes with green buses and old shops and others showed the modern side of Fareham.

Now that the Exhibition is over, we return to our usual weekly painting sessions and start planning for next year.
